*A Message from Father Kendrick*

I have noticed that physical distancing is not always adhered to while people enter and exit the church at Mass. While some don’t see it as a big deal, others do.

In some cases, some are still cautious about returning to Mass when they hear of laxities being taken against the guidelines. We must be vigilant, especially for the sake of those of us who are more vulnerable.

I believe it best at this time to ask people to wear non-medical masks as we enter and exit the Churches. Technically we should, since the isles are not wide enough to ensure two meter distancing while people enter and exit. According to the Sask. Public Health Measures “Non-medical or cloth face coverings can play an important role in situations and community settings where physical distancing is not possible or is unpredictable....”

So please do bring a mask when you come to Mass. We will have some on hand for those who forget or do not have one, but we ask people to bring their own. Thank you for your compliance, and don’t forget to offer up your inconveniences as penance for the conversion of sinners.
