Gospel Reflection

We are hungry people, and I mean hungry in the deepest sense possible. Our hunger is for more than food and drink. We have appetites, strong appetites; appetites for fun, meaning, and excitement; appetites for friendship, affection, and marriage; and appetites for truth, goodness and beauty. Moreover, these appetites cannot be fully satisfied by any good thing we find on earth. Why are we so hungry

that nothing on earth can satisfy us? God made us so. Why? Because God wants to satisfy us. We are made with a capacity for God Himself, and with that comes a hunger that is boundless.

It seems to me that satisfying a desire is a greater good than to have no desire in the first place. If a guest were to say they were not hungry, and refused to eat, it makes for less pleasant company. But if a host can satisfy a guest, then there is joy for both, the guest for having been satisfied, and the host for having satisfied. We learn today from our Lord's great sign of the multiplication of the loaves that God wants to satisfy us. He made us hungry so that we could learn to hunger for Him. But of course He is not satisfied with merely satisfying our pallet and stomach; He wants to satisfy our whole being, every desire and every need. He wants to satisfy us with the one thing that can fill us to overflowing—Himself.
