Holiness is nothing other than doing the will of God. We learn from the parable that it is not enough to simply say we will do God's will, we need to actually do it. And it's hard! The expression is true:

Should We Have Music During Mass? A Message from Father Kendrick

It is looking like we will be in COVID mode for a while. I recognize it has been a real heartache not having music during Mass (I feel it too), and it is perhaps something we should be discussing.

It is possible according to the guidelines, but there are some serious drawbacks, and the question is whether it is worth it.

We cannot have choirs, only a cantor and musician.

Ideally, the congregation would not sing along, but I don't think that is realistic in our musical communities.

If the congregation is going to sing (not recommended) people would have to wear masks. And because it is not good to constantly remove, put on, adjust, remove, put on, adjust, it would mean people would be asked to wear masks all through Mass. This seems to be the trade-off in our situation. We either all wear masks all through Mass, or we continue to worship without music.

If we do have music, we would have to be careful to make sure all music is licensed by our streaming license (which we have), and all music would have to be reported. This is an extra burden on musicians and myself, and our repertoire would be very limited.

Anyways I would very much appreciate any comments, thoughts, or opinions around this issue.
