Gospel Reflection

There are two kind of laws: positive laws, and negative laws. We are familiar with the Ten Commandments, which are negative laws; they say what we should not do. The first three commands are prohibitions as we relate to God, and the last seven are prohibitions as we relate to others. These are

important, and yet when asked what law is most important, our Lord goes to the positive expression of the law: "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind." Keeping the commandments is more than avoiding evil, nor is it desirable that we should seek to do the minimum. Loving God with all one's heart, soul and mind means every part of our existence, our consciousness, our will, and thoughts should have our Father and his will as their object. Further, a second is like it: "You shall love your neighbour as yourself." When we Love God, we will have a love for what He loves too, and so love our neighbour as ourselves.
