The Christmas season gives us so many great feasts and mysteries to ponder.

December 25 is obviously the event of Christ's Nativity;

God comes to us to save us; salvation has entered into the world.

The Sunday after Christmas is usually the Feast of the Holy family; Christ was born into a family.

January 1 is the solemnity of Mary, the Holy mother of God, which tells us that Christ is truly God and truly man.

December 26, 27, and 28 show the effects of Christmas by showing three types of martyrdom. And we might think, "What does martyrdom have to do with Christmas?" It is the season of the birth, and martyrdom is less about a person's death, and more about their birth into eternal life in heaven.

St. Stephen is the first person to be martyred for Christ as he was stoned to death for proclaiming Jesus Christ. His martyrdom exemplifies the martyrdom by his will, his love, and his blood. John is the only apostle who did not die by being killed for the faith (although he did suffer torture that should have killed him).

His martyrdom is of will, and love, but not blood.

Finally, there is the feast of the Holy Innocents who gave their life for the newborn Saviour, not able by will or love, but by blood.

May Christ's birth on earth lead all of us to new birth in heaven.
