Reflection "Look, here is the Lamb of God!" Most people don't realize the profundity of these words. Many think that John calling Jesus a lamb has to do with Him being "gentle as a lamb" or something cozy. But this is not it at all. Jesus is the Sacrificial Lamb of God—the new Passover Lamb of the new exodus!

The early witness of St. Justin Martyr describes how passover lambs were sacrificed in the 1st century: "For the lamb, which is roasted, is roasted and dressed up in the form of the cross. For one spit is transfixed right through from the lower parts up to the head, and one across the back. to which are attached the legs of the lamb." Our Lord is the Passover Lamb of God. The crucified one who's blood saves us.

Pope Francis has named next Sunday as the **"Sunday of the Word of God."** Sacred Scripture is so important. The inspired word is God speaking to us.
