A Message from Father Kendrick

We are so quick to label people.

We see a person doing something, or not doing something, and we make all sorts of assumptions and jump to all sorts of conclusions about their motivations. A wise priest once wittily told me that it is best to leave the assumptions to our Lady.

Perhaps the problem is less that we judge people, but more that we misjudge people. We need to listen to people and their stories, their concerns, their sufferings and their pains.

The problem is we are so superficial in our culture.

We can talk about the weather for about 30 seconds before the conversation starts getting awkward or we devolve into complaining about COVID restrictions.

Here's a difficult challenge; let's try having a meaningful conversation with someone: “How are you doing?” “I'm fine” “No, No. How are you actually doing?”
