Devotion to the **Sacred Heart of Jesus** is one of the most popular Catholic devotions. Jesus appeared to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque in 1673, showing her a vision of the now-famous image of His Sacred Heart, surrounded by flames. He said to her: "My Heart is so full of love for men that It can no longer contain the flames of Its burning love. I must discover to men the treasures of My Heart and save them from perdition." She was given the special mission to spread devotion to His Sacred Heart throughout the Church. Jesus gave St. Margaret Mary many promises associated with this devotion, and requested that a feast day in honor of His Sacred Heart be instituted on the Friday after the Octave of Corpus Christi. In 1856, the Feast of the Sacred Heart was spread to the Universal Church, and in 1899 Pope

Leo XIII solemnly consecrated all mankind to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, calling it "the great act" of his pontificate.

Vocation Corner ~6th Sunday of Easter It is not that talents add up to a vocation; but rather a Vocation brings talents. The Spirit of God lives within you!

Prayer: That men and women discerning their vocation will not let their hearts be troubled or afraid, but rather will find comfort and guidance in the Holy Spirit

Action: "THE SECRET OF A VOCATION," Pope Benedict XVI told youth, "lies in the capacity and in the joy of distinguishing [God's] voice, of listening to and following His voice. But to do this, it is necessary to accustom our heart to recognize the Lord, to hear Him like a person who is near me and who loves me."

Moments of "interior silence in the day-to-day routine" are essential, he said. "But once one has learned to hear this voice and to generously follow it, "one fears nothing, he or she knows and feels that God is with him or her, and that He is a Friend, Father, and Brother."

I have told you this . . . (John 14:25)

Grief, fear, and anxiety. What a range of emotions the disciples must have felt as they listened to Jesus' final words before His arrest and crucifixion! And yet in today's Gospel, Jesus is also making a number of promises that surely sustained them in the days and years ahead. Amazingly, these same promises are also meant for us.

Whoever loves me will keep my word, . . . and we will come to Him and make our dwelling with Him (John 14:23). Jesus will be put to death, rise, and then ascend to heaven, but He is still present to us. When we follow Him, He promises not just to accompany us but to live in us! He is as close to us as we are to ourselves.

The Advocate, the Holy Spirit, . . . will teach you everything (John 14:26). Jesus taught His followers many things that the Gospels record, but He wants to continue speaking to our minds and hearts. That's why He sent us the Holy Spirit. He will lead us and guide us in every situation we face.

My peace I give to you (John 14:27). After Jesus' ascension, the disciples will face persecution and even martyrdom. But despite these trials, Jesus' peace will remain with them. They will know a wholeness and tranquility

that can only come from the Lord. This is His gift to us as well.

How have you seen these promises fulfilled in your walk with the Lord? Think of all the times you have felt His presence in your heart. Recall when the Holy Spirit helped you understand more about the Lord or guided you in a specific way. Remember how God's peace descended on you in a hectic or difficult time.

God always fulfills His promises. So wherever you find yourself today, believe what Jesus has "told you" (John 14:25, 29). Then look for how He is working in your life, just as He said He would! "Jesus, help me to trust in your promises!"
